The PE Department have recently reviewed the PE kit and are pleased to announce that we will be introducing a new range of garments from September 2019. We are hoping that the new kit will motivate performance during PE lessons and encourage a sense of pride when representing the school.

We appreciate that not all our students will need a new kit in September, therefore the new kit will be rolled out as compulsory to new Year 7 students from September and will filter through to the rest of the school as students need to replace items. The new kit is of very high quality, attractive, durable and offers excellent value for money. All new items will be available to buy from 3rd June 2019 from our usual supplier, Sportswear International, by clicking on the link on the Uniform tab on the school website.

Having the correct kit is crucial for students to access the PE curriculum in order to progress and fulfil their potential in PE. Students need to be organised and ensure they consistently bring the correct PE kit to lessons. The PE Department operate a 'consequence system' for students who fail to bring kit altogether OR if they forget enough of it to access the lesson. **Students will not be allowed to borrow kit from school.**

Occasion:	No kit at all/Incorrect Kit/Items of kit missing:
1 <sup>st</sup> time	Student receives a 30 minute Friday lunch time detention If students are late or miss the detention then this will escalate to a one hour after school detention
2 <sup>nd</sup> time	Student receives a 30 minute Friday lunch time detention If students are late or miss the detention then this will escalate to a one hour after school detention
3 <sup>rd</sup> time and thereafter	Student receives a one hour after school detention If students fail to attend then this will escalate to a SLT two hour after school detention

**If there is any reason for your child being excused physically from PE, you MUST send a signed note with your child explaining why. Students MUST ALSO still bring kit as normal as they will be expected to take an active (non-physical) role in the lesson to ensure there is no detrimental impact on learning. PE lessons take place in outside teaching spaces and there isn't always the option of an inside area being available. In this situation your child will be required to be outside with the main group.**
